Faith	Strong belief in a religion, based on spiritual conviction
Declaration	A formal statement or announcement
Belonging	An affinity for a place or situation. "we feel a real sense of belonging"
Membership	The fact of being a member of a group.
Baptism	The Christian religious rite of sprinkling water on to a person's forehead or of immersing them in water.
Initiation Ceremony	<b>Initiation</b> is a rite of passage marking entrance or acceptance into a group or society. It could also be a formal admission to adulthood in a community.
