| Christianity | The religion based on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ, or its beliefs and practices. |
| Sacred | Connected to a religion and treated with great respect |
| God | A greatly admired person. |
| Jesus | The person at the centre of the Christian religion. |
| Cross | Jesus died on the cross. It is a symbol of sacrifice, suffering and hope. |
| Bible | The Christian holy book containing stories about Jesus. |
| Altar | A raised area in the Church where people can honour God with offerings. |
| Priest / Vicar | The person who runs the church. |

| Jew | A person who is a believer of Judaism |
| Rabbi | Jewish religious leader and teacher |
| Ark | The place where the Torah is kept in a synagogue |
| Torah | The Jewish holy book |

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Places of worship are important to the local community. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Special Objects and symbols found in a church or synagogue are important to believers. Be able to say something about what they mean and how they are used. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recognise that there are special places where people go to worship, and talk about what people do there. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about an object that is used in worship, saying how it is used and how it shows what people believe. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask appropriate and respectful questions of believers. |



The Church is a special place for Christian people. Christian people go to Church to pray, listen to stories about Jesus and sing songs.



The Synagogue is a special place for Jewish people. Jewish people go to a Synagogue to pray, read the Torah scroll and sing songs.
