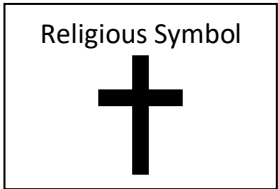


What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today? RE Knowledge Organiser

Key Vocabulary	
Christians	A person who is a believer in Christianity
Prayer	A request for help or expression of thanks address to God
Denomination	The word denomination is used for a large group of <u>Christian</u> people right across the world who use the same name, the same sort of organisation and have the same (or very similar) beliefs
Baptist	A denomination of Christianity
Roman Catholic	A denomination of Christianity
Worship	The feeling or expression of admiration for a God
Church	A place of worship
Congregation	A group of people assembled for religious worship
Community	A group that have certain attitudes and interests in common
Religion	A way of faith worship



Places of Worship – Church (these can look very different)



Key Knowledge
Christians pray, go to church, say thanks before food and read the bible. Christians can go to places of worship or worship from home
Christians show their belief through prayer, reading bible passages. Easter/Christmas services, helping in their local community
<u>Christianity</u> is divided into five main groups (denominations). These groups all branched out at different dates from the <u>early Christianity</u> founded by the <u>followers</u> of <u>Jesus</u> . The splits generally happened because they could not agree on certain beliefs or practices. The groups then divided into smaller groups. Each group that has its own separate name is a "denomination".
Different churches hold different events to help their community e.g. kids clubs, toddler groups, groups for the elderly, charity events in order to develop a community.
