

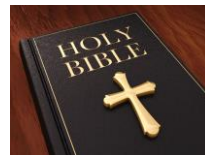
**Key Vocabulary**

Religion	A way of faith and worship.
Christianity	The religion based on the life and teachings of Jesus Christ.
Christians	A person who is a believer in Christianity.
Church	A place of worship.
Worship	The feeling or expression of admiration for God.
Bible	The Christian Holy book, consisting of the Old and New Testaments.
Hymns	A religious song or poem of praise to God or a god.
Prayer	A request for help or expression of thanks addressed to God.
Palm Cross	The cross represents Jesus death because he died on a cross.
Crucifix	A representation of a cross with a figure of Christ on it.
Holy water	Water blessed by a priest and used in religious ceremonies.
Rosary	A string of beads or knotted rope used by Catholics to recite prayers.

Christianity is focused on the life and teachings of Jesus Christ. They believe that he is the Son of God.

Christians believe there is only one God but that he is revealed in three different forms; God the Father, God the Son and The Holy Spirit.

Jesus' most important messages from God were to love God and your neighbours (everyone) and to look after one another.

Christians practice their beliefs at home and at church. They pray, say grace/thanks before food and read biblical stories.

Christians show their belief through prayer, reading bible passages. Easter/Christmas services, helping in their local community

Christian households may differ between family but most have some objects which represent their faith.
