At our school we know that being safe online is very important. We learn how to keep safe online through Project Evolve, our PSHE lessons and our computing lessons.

We know to be kind online, and speak up and speak out if something is not right.

I agree to:

- Be responsible for my behaviour when using the internet, including social media platforms, games and apps. This includes the resources I access and the language I use. I will not use offensive language online. This includes mobile phone messaging apps or group chats.
- Not deliberately browse, download or upload material that could be considered offensive or illegal. If I accidentally come across something that I think is wrong or makes me uncomfortable or unhappy I will report it immediately to the teacher or another trusted adult.
- Not send anyone material that could be considered threatening, bullying, offensive or illegal.
- Not give out any personal information online, such as my name, age, gender, school, photos, phone number or address.
- Not reveal my passwords to anyone.
- Not arrange a face-to-face meeting with someone I meet online unless I have discussed this with my parents and/or teacher / trusted adult and am accompanied by a trusted adult.
- Tell a trusted adult if I am concerned or upset about anything I see on the internet or any messages that I receive, I know I can talk to my parents, teachers, middays, Mrs Houseman, Mrs Tomlinson, and any other adults in school.
- I will not share images of other people without their consent (permission).

I understand that my internet use at Dovedale Primary School will be monitored and logged to keep me safe

I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe and that if I choose not to follow them the head teacher will be informed and my parents may be contacted.
