Dear Parents,

In response to the parent's questionnaire and the rising costs faced by our families we are endeavoring to offer further after school clubs run by the teachers or teaching assistants. The majority of these will be free or a small fee.

The staff have kindly come forward with their offers and we are spreading them out across the school year. We have had many clubs for Autumn and Spring terms and are now organising clubs for the first half of the Summer term (Summer 1). These clubs will run from after Easter up to the May half term holiday. Please be aware that there are 2 bank holiday Mondays during this half term.

If you feel your child(ren) would like to attend one of the clubs on offer please place their preferences in order of 1,2,3 only.

Children will only be allocated 1 club space. Naturally we do not know the uptake so will attempt to ensure that all children attend at least 1 free club over this school year if they wish to do so.

Please be aware that we will only be able to allocate a certain number of children to each club.

We hope that this will provide the children with a wider range of experiences and opportunities. Other clubs will still run alongside these led by outside providers.

Please check the key stage/year groups allocated for each club. KS1 is Year 1 and Year 2. KS2 is Years 3,4,5 and 6
