Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to be able to confirm further details for the activities week to celebrate the end of your child's time at Dovedale. Each section contains information about what will be happening on each day and the arrangements for that day. As previously advised, the cost of all these activities is met by the amount on the previous letter. Please could we request that the cost is met by Monday 5th July through School Money. Please contact the office if you have trouble with this.

We have taken advice from Derbyshire County Council with regards to the activities and will have all appropriate risk assessments in place with specific attention given to any Covid risk assessments necessary.

As from 15th July the year 6s will be classed as 1 bubble to allow them to complete the activities with their friends. We will however continue to follow guidelines and ensure all procedures are followed.

Friday 16th July – School Sleepover and Sporting Themed Day

We have lots of exciting things planned for the sleepover including watching a film with a chippy tea! The school day will run with the usual timings. We are planning on having a sports themed day in school that day so want to give the children a chance to shower and change out of their PE kit ready for the sleepover. Please drop them off on the Friday at 5:30pm and collect on the Saturday morning at 9am. We will provide breakfast for them in the morning. The children will need the following items:

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- Something to sleep on such as a blow up bed
- Sleeping Bag or something similar
- Pyjamas
- Toiletries such as toothpaste and toothbrush
- Teddy Bear – If they're not too embarrassed!
- Feel free to send them with a snack!

The children will be having a chippy tea in the evening from Georges. Please could you fill out the slip at the end of this letter indicating their choice of meal. The children **should not** bring their mobile phone with them to the sleepover. We will contact you if there is an issue. If you wish to discuss anything about the sleepover, please contact your child's class teacher. The children will sleep in groups of 6 as per our risk assessment following guidance.

Monday 19th July – Spring Lakes

Meet at school at 8:30am sharp ready for a fun and splash filled day! We'll walk to Spring Lakes from school together and have an action packed day with the various different activities stopping only to sit and have lunch together. Please could you provide your child with a packed lunch for the day. If your child normally receives free school meals the school kitchen can make them a packed lunch to take with them on the day. Please indicate this on the form overleaf. Attached to this letter is a waiver form required by Spring Lakes, which gives consent for your child to take part in the activities. It would be helpful and save time if your children came with their swimwear on underneath their clothes although if you would prefer them not to they can change at Spring Lakes. If they do come with their swimwear on, please don't forget a change of underwear to put on afterwards! If your child has their own wetsuit, feel free to bring it along and they are able to wear that. You will need to collect your children at approximately 3:30. We realise that if you have siblings to collect from school you may arrive later than this. Feel free to arrange lifts with each other for who is collecting who. Just let us know nearer the time who your child will be going home with.

Tuesday 20th July Picnic in the Park and the Great Dovedale Bake Off!

In the morning we'll bake to produce some showstoppers and decorate biscuits and cakes. In the afternoon we'll go and eat them on West Park. We'll go after lunch, so the normal school lunch will apply.

Wednesday 21st July – Arts and Crafts Day and water fight BBQ.

Not much more to add for this one! We'll spend the day making lots of lovely crafts to help us remember our time at Dovedale.

We'll also be having a BBQ to celebrate the end of the school year. The school day will end as normal. The children should then return to school at 4:15pm ready for a disco, BBQ, games and of course the end of school water fight. Feel free to bring in your water pistols, so the teachers can have first choice on the best ones! We know they won't want to leave, but please come and collect them at 6:15pm!

Thursday 22nd July – Final Day

This will be a time to do all the leavers day activities such as shirt signing, photos with friends can be taken on their mobile phones at a specified period and we'll also do all of the other things associated with that day.
